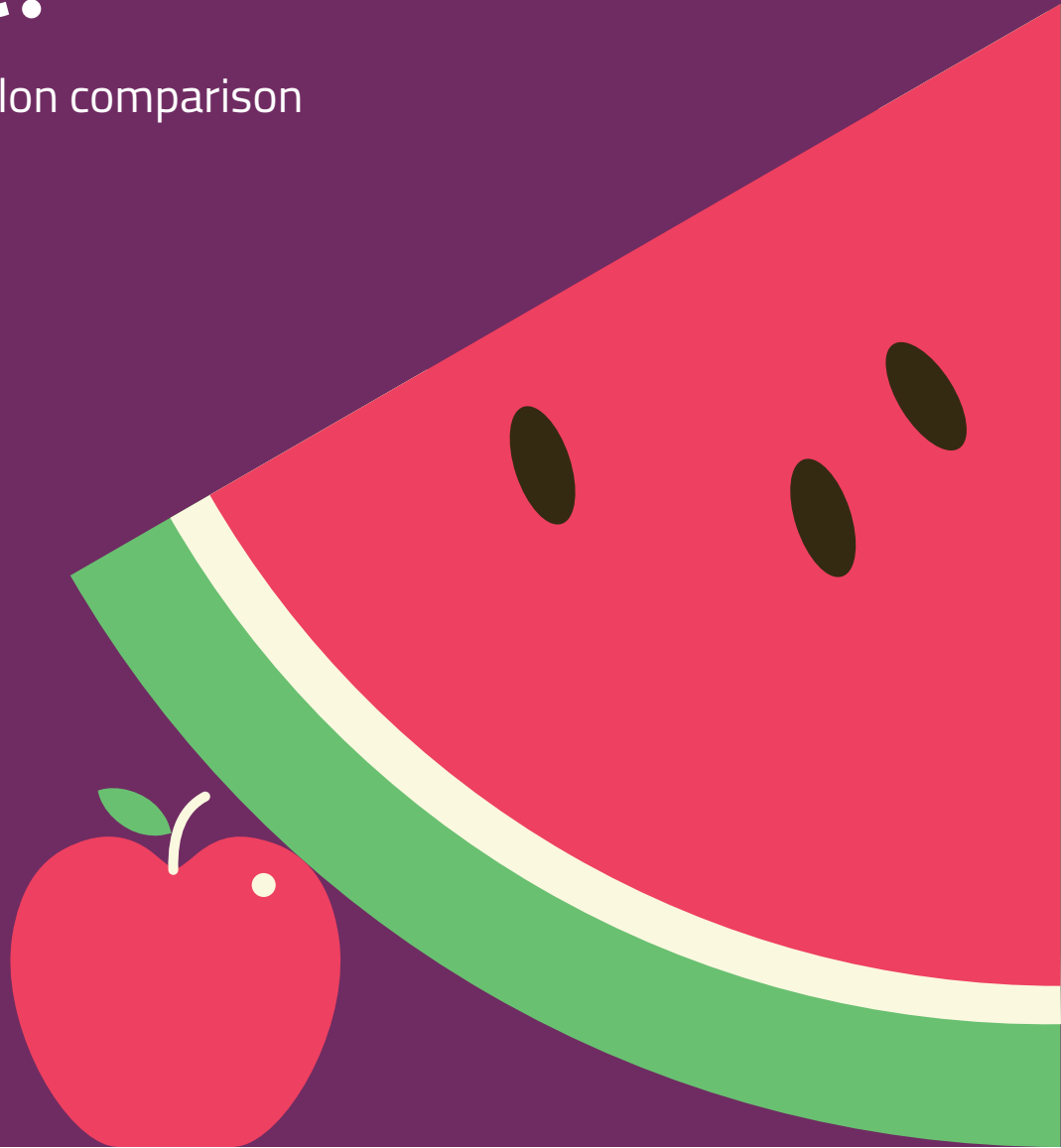




# Hospital employee and occupational health software:

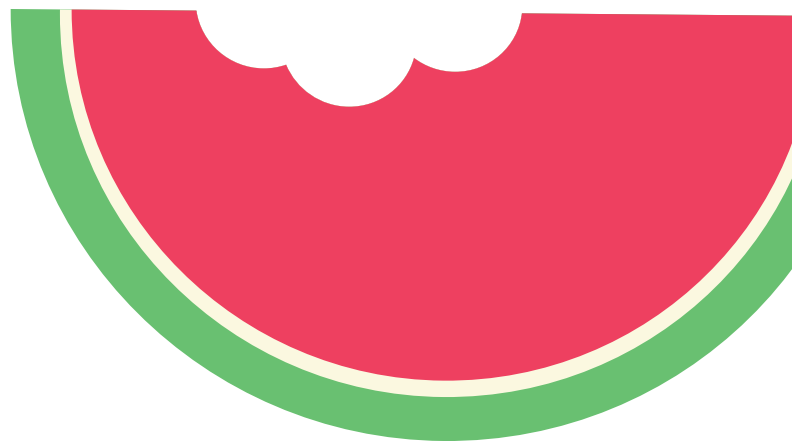
## Employee/occupational health platform
